Provision of Sports Training for Staff

- The MDSA's continue to be supported by a member of staff from 'Up and Under Sports' on a weekly basis. This member of staff has worked alongside the MDSA's in developing teamwork &, cooperation & communication through the use of team games and have organised several internal inter-house competitions.
- Trained outside coaches from Up and Under Sports assisted by PH Sports continuing to work alongside some of our most challenging children, promoting and rewarding the children through the values of sport. Coaches work in school for two hours a day, five days per week.
- Participation in local inter school sporting competitions organised by the Wiltshire Sports Partnership.
- The purchasing of a secure space to store outdoor PE equipment.
- Ensuring the school PE resources reflect the needs of both the curriculum and its growing numbers on roll through the maintenance & replacing of broken equipment.
- Staff CPD opportunities i.e. Cricket training led by qualified ECB coaches.

Curriculum focus of Sports Grant spending 2020/2021
