#### **Early Finish**

We will, as usual, have an early finish on Friday 18<sup>th</sup> December. Ducklings, Goslings, Pufflings & Cygnet will finish at 12.30pm, Teal, Eider & Sandpiper will finish at 12.50pm, Curlew, Avocet & Mallard will finish at 1.10pm

### Track & Trace

During the middle of last week, the government asked schools to consider making the last day of term (Friday 18th December) an INSET Day. By making this a day when pupils are not in school, the government hoped to ensure that any track and trace processes (needed when a pupil tests positive for C-19) can then be completed before 24th December. Priestley did consider this course of action, but due to the extremely late notice and the fact that we already had two TD Days booked in for January it was decided to continue as planned, finishing school at lunchtime on Friday 18<sup>th</sup> December.

They have also published their requirements with regards to 'Track & Trace' over the Christmas period. These are as follows:

 Where a pupil or staff member tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms more than 48 hours since being in school, the school should not be contacted for track and trace processes. Parents and carers should follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.

- For the first 6 days after teaching ends, if a pupil or staff member tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms within 48 hours of being in school, the school is asked to assist in identifying close contacts and advising self-isolation, as the individual may have been infectious whilst in school.
- School staff are not asked to remain on-call or conduct any contact tracing more than 6 days after the final day of teaching. Where a school's last teaching day is on Thursday 17th December, there should be no pupil contact tracing beyond Wednesday 23rd December.
- For the first 6 days after the end of term, schools are not asked to be on-call at all times. Staff responsible for contact tracing may designate a limited period in the day to receive notification of positive cases and advise close contacts to self-isolate (this can be done by email). The Department for Education coronavirus (COVID-19) helpline and PHE advice service are available to support with any queries you have about positive cases in your school.

So, therefore, we are asking that if your child does return a positive COVID-19 test during those first few days of the holiday whilst having started to have symptoms during the last couple of days of term that you let the school know asap via emailing <a href="mailto:ask@priestley.wilts.sch.uk">ask@priestley.wilts.sch.uk</a>, leaving the child's name & date of positive test. This email address will be accessed up until the 24<sup>th</sup> December for this purpose.

So, with all these exceptional circumstances in mind we will be holding our final Teams 'Star of the Term' Assembly on Thursday morning. Therefore, any absence on Friday 18<sup>th</sup> December will on this occasion be authorised.
