Provision of Sports Training for Staff

- The MDSA's continue to be supported by a member of staff from 'Up and Under Sports' on a weekly basis. This member of staff has worked alongside the MDSA's and have organised several internal inter-house competitions so far.
- Up and Under Sports assisted by PH Sports continue to work alongside our most challenging children, promoting and rewarding the children through the values of sport. Coaches work in school for two hours a day, five days per week.
- Swimming is provided from year 2 4 each year and PE Premium is used to subsidise the cost of these sessions.
- Participation in local inter school sporting competitions organised by the Wiltshire Sports Partnership.
- Hiring a Climbing Wall for the day to allow pupils to try a new physical activity.
